

“Wallet, keys, phone...” and in my case, add “purse, water or coffee...” Many of us have such a mantra that we recite as we leave home to ensure we are ready for the day.

As I pray about today’s Gospel, I find myself reflecting on several things:

- Jesus invites others to help spread the good news, do as He did, and continue His work and carry His message out into an unprepared world.
- Jesus does not ask of them more than He does Himself. He has left His family and home and has become a wandering preacher. He lives on the margins of society and battles against the evil of a broken world. He invites people into a deep relationship with God.
- This is not about self-sufficiency. Jesus instructs them to go out and do this in pairs, not alone. Sometimes this commission is hard work, and sharing it with another, having the support and friendship of others, lightens the load.
- Jesus also invites His followers to shake off and leave behind hostility, resistance, and unfriendliness.
- In Jesus’ time, communication of the good news had to be by word of mouth and requires moving from house to house. It seems that Jesus stresses not only the message as the medium but also the lifestyle of the message bearers. In other words, the emphasis is on “acts and not just words.” Dom Helder Camara, the saintly Brazilian bishop, used to tell his catechists who were speaking to those who could not read: “Sisters and brothers, watch how you live. Your lives may be the only Gospel your listeners will ever read.”
- In this commission of these wandering preachers, we see the beginnings of our 2000+-year-old story of the Church.

My last reflection is, in some ways, my most challenging: If I were the receiver of the message, would I be open to hearing what these wandering

preachers had to say? Would I welcome them into my home and provide them with a roof, sustenance, and sanctuary, or would I close my door (my heart, my mind, my spirit) to them?

Who are those wandering preachers today? And how do they show up in my life? God’s word and insights, and my growth opportunity, can arrive in mysterious or unexpected ways.

Since January, I have had the honor of spending time with two groups of Casa community members who spent six weeks participating in the *Ubuntu Spirit of Solidarity* course. The “*Ubuntu*” course is part of the Act Justly, Love Tenderly, Walk Humbly (or Act Love Walk Series) curriculum that the Casa offers on justice formation through a Franciscan lens. South African Archbishop Desmond Tutu defines *Ubuntu* as “My humanity is caught up, is inextricably bound up, in what is yours.”

Many of the things of the world can be distractions: accumulation of wealth to the detriment of others, desire for recognition, and personal pride can inhibit our desire for God and our freedom to love and do good. During this course, the participants became a mirror for each other. We faced the spiritual and emotional challenges of the past year: a global pandemic, racial injustice, migration, unemployment, affordable housing issues, and a lot of disagreement in the public square. And we took ownership of the parts we play. Ultimately, regardless of status, birthplace, religion, or skin color, we are all of the *Imago Dei*, the image of God. We are all beloved of God.

When baptized, every Christian shares in Christ’s mission. The instructions boil down to two words: trust and perseverance. He sends us out with less, inviting us to trust, to be ready to engage with and respond to the world around us.

Fearlessness of Faith

In the Gospel for this weekend, Jesus does something that might have some of us feeling a little sorry for His disciples. He sends them out on a mission to do ministry, and all He equipped them with was their relationship with Him, the clothes on their backs, a walking stick, sandals, and companionship of another disciple! I have to think that if I were one of these disciples, I might have pushed back on those instructions just a bit. But not only were they fearless in their faith and response to His direction; they were also abundantly successful in their mission!

As a parent, there have been times when I have wondered how well equipped I am to pass on or share our faith with my children. But as parents, that is the mission that has been given to us by our Lord. It was the promise we made at our children's baptism. It is the daily call that we are expected to answer. So, how do we do this, like the disciples, fearlessly? The disciples were able to respond with fearless acceptance because of their faith and love for Jesus. They trusted Him completely that He would not send them off to do an impossible task. The same is true for us as parents. We can fully and completely trust that we are equipped and will be successful in the mission with which God has blessed us.

Part of our focus for this coming year in Family Catechesis will be learning how to live out our faith as Christian parents fearlessly! And just like the disciples in today's Gospel, I am excited for our journey!




